A Message from the Pastor Chheng Nuon

Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Thank you for your ever diligent support for the Mission to Cambodia. In the name of the Lord Jesus Christ many good works are being performed in Cambodia. God has blessed the Church of Mercy and there are so many things for us to be thankful of.

Several weeks ago the Church of Mercy began experiencing a surge of visitors and we now have three times more attendees on Sunday than before. The visitors consist of adults, young adults and children, and many continue to visit every Sunday.

Due to the surge of visitors we have begun a second service on Sunday in the evenings because we are unable to accommodate for everyone at one service. The morning service consists of around 200 + attendees, whereas the evening service has about 50 but is steadily growing.

We now have 9 Sunday school classes to also accommodate for the increase in visitors to our church.

The church still offers English classes Monday through Saturday to the local children, but we have now added an additional computer class about 1 month ago. There are 20 computer classes offered Monday through Saturday along with the English classes.

The teachers are students from the Discipleship Center, and often teach both the evening English and computer classes in addition to the Sunday school classes. Many of the students will have 2-3 classes that they teach.

During the summer the students and church members meet twice a week for prayer meetings. They have also been going out every day to preach the gospel to all areas around the church. Please pray that the Lord will reach out to those who do not yet know our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ.

We are so thankful and overjoyed for how the Lord is blessing the mission in Cambodia with this time of growth. We wish to share together with you our excitement and joy, and are ever thankful for your support and prayers!
